eLEARNING AND TEACHER TRAINING

Challenges:

- Variety of ICT capabilities required
- Lack of Pan-African framework
- Poor policy to raise teachers' ICT capability
- Low priority to ICT funding
- Shortage of local relevant materials
- Reluctance to invest in teachers' skills
