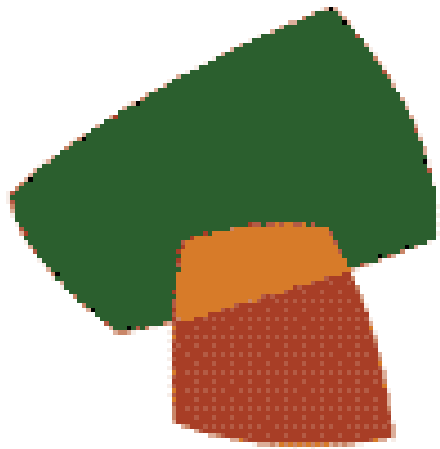

Teacher Education in Sub-Saharan Africa

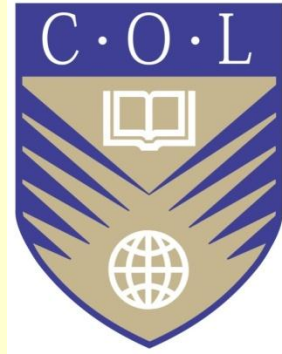
Last year 320,000 African teachers worked with TESSA materials in 19 teacher education programmes.
